CLUB ENTRY REGULATIONS

- Club members must show their card on arrival
- Bona-fide visitors to the club must show residential identification and sign the visitors book
- Members of Reciprocal clubs must produce their reciprocal club membership card

DRESS REGULATIONS

NIGHT TIME DRESS REGULATIONS COMMENCE AT 6.30PM

Adult patrons entering the club after 6.30pm must observe night time dress regulations Members and guests must be clean, neat and tidy in appearance and must be inoffensive to others

NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME

- No Mens, Ladies and Children's Headwear of any kind
 (with the exception of Ladies formal headwear, when part of formal attire i.e. Melbourne Cup, Weddings etc and medical conditions noted and approved by manager on duty)
- No Swimwear
- No Mens Singlets or Mens Sleeveless Shirts
- No Tracksuits/Fleecy Pants/Hoodies or any kind of surplus clothing tied around the waist
- No Dirty Work Clothes or Dirty Work Boots
- No Football Attire
 - (Football Supporters Jerseys are permitted to be worn on special occasions, such as State of Origin Nights)
- No items of clothing with rude or offensive designs or writing
- No Bikies Club Colours
- No Moccasins/Slippers
- No Ripped or Torn Clothing
- No Provocative Clothing (women must not wear revealing singlets, midriff or immodest tops)

NOT PERMITTED AFTER 6.30PM

- No Rubber Thongs/Scuffs/Surf Sandals/Masseur Sandals/Crocs
- No Stubbies
- No T Shirts

These types of sandals are permitted provided they are leather and of clean and tidy appearance and may be worn with or without socks



Service may be refused if the apparel worn does not fit these parameters or is judged to be untidy or is in any way inappropriate
