



COVID 19 - RELEASE AND WAIVER



1. These terms and conditions apply to any person wishing to play golf or make a booking for competition or social golf until further notice at Horton Park Golf Club Maroochy Inc trading as Maroochy River Golf Club. ("Club")
2. By choosing to play golf or making a booking at the Club, you agree to the terms and conditions set out below and provide a release and waiver in favour of the Club and all of its employees, officers, agents and contractors.
3. You agree to strictly comply with the Covid-19 Rules of Play issued by the Club, which are clearly displayed at the pro shop and various other places around the club and course.
4. You accept all liability for loss or damage caused by a failure to comply with clause 3.
5. By making a booking or choosing to play golf, you accept all risks associated with electing to play golf in the current Covid 19 or coronavirus conditions that could result in loss of life, personal injury, property damage or permanent injury. Accordingly, you release the Club and all persons or corporations associated directly or indirectly with the Club from all claims demands and proceedings arising out of your choosing to do so.
6. This release and indemnity shall extend to and include the Club, and its respective directors, officers, managers, agents, contractors and employees.
7. This release and indemnity shall continue forever and binds your heirs, executors, personal representatives and assigns.
8. Any dispute or claim arising out of, relating to or in connection with your participation in the golfing activities, shall be governed by the law of Queensland, Australia and the courts of that State.

COVID-19 RULE OF PLAY

1. DO NOT Arrive at the course more than 15 minutes before your tee time.
2. If Possible DO NOT Park your car next to another car in the car park & leave a space with a car park between each car.
3. DO NOT congregate in the locker room when collecting golf clubs.
4. Walk up play is not available and bookings are through the time sheets only.
5. Competition play will be available from 6:15 till 12:33 each day, all other time slots will be for social play only.
6. Tee times will be restricted to pairs and in 7 minute intervals.
7. Only one person per cart (Exception: family members living in the same dwelling) Players may place 2 bags on one cart but one player must walk
8. All players must abide with the mandatory social distancing regulations which state that you must not be closer than 1.5 metres to another person
9. **STORM WARNINGS PROCEDURES**-in the event of storm warnings please remove yourself from the golf course, and return to your car until the course is again safe for play.

The temporary local rules brought in a few weeks ago are still in place for all players

10. Flag sticks must not be removed from the hole
11. All rakes will be removed from the course, players shall be able to take a preferred lie (one club length, no nearer the hole) for all ball that come to rest in a bunker.
12. Players are to mark their own card and these are not required to be signed by the partner.
13. **CARD SCANNING**-only 2 people are allowed in the card scanning area at one time, other players are to line up on the X marked in tape on the ground outside the door 1.5 metres apart. Only 2 machines will be open for scanning with social distancing in place.
14. Only 4 people are allowed in the Pro Shop at any one time (This includes the pro shop staff)
15. No alcohol to be brought onto the course by players & No alcohol can be sold to players
16. When players are finished their game, all players **MUST** leave the course immediately and not congregate around the clubhouse;
17. Driving range access will be limited to 10 people in total with witches' hats separating the hitting areas
18. You will be required to check-in with the Pro Shop before heading to the range.
19. The practice chipping/bunker area access will be limited to 4 people in total.
20. The practice putting green will remain closed

In addition to these restrictions we ask:

21. If you are symptomatic - even if you 'know' it is just a cold, please stay away.
22. If you have been in close contact with someone who already has COVID-19, please stay away;
23. If you have been in close contact with someone who already has COVID-19 or otherwise subject to a Government-regulated quarantine, now including having travelled from interstate, please stay away. You are not welcome until the quarantine period has passed;

The Prime Minister has also given "strong advice" for people over the age of 70, and people over the age of 60 with chronic illnesses to stay at home. We encourage Members to heed this advice.

The staff will be disinfecting items such as door handles and taps around the on course amenities as well as the range bucket handles.

It is also the responsibility of members to ensure they practice social hygiene while playing, both amenities buildings are equipped with soap and water and all players are advised to wash their hands thoroughly each time they pass one of the amenity buildings.

Anyone found contravening the above rules will be removed from the course immediately and will be suspended from the club for a minimum of 3 months.
