1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18)

i) Beyond any line of white stakes.

- ii) Beyond the "Conservation Zones" posts/signs on the 13th hole.
- iii) The driving range to the right of the 9th hole.
- iv) Beyond the course side edge of the cart path behind greens 9 & 18 as defined by white lines or white stakes.

2. No Play Zone

Beyond the Conservation Zones posts marked Red with a Green top on the 6th, 7th, 8th & 9th holes. Play is prohibited from these areas. **Compulsory Drop under penalty of one Shot.**

3. Red Penalty Areas (Rule 17)

All Dams, Waterways and Garden Beds on the course are Red Penalty Areas. Red Penalty Areas are identified by red stakes or where a red line exists, the line defines the margin. Where no line exists, the stakes and/or the hazards natural margin define the hazard.

4. Abnormal Course Conditions (Including Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16)

- i) All concrete cart paths and blue metal surfaced roadways.
- ii) Staked Trees/Shrubs If a staked tree/shrub interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball MUST be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 14.3b. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted. NOTE: Stakes protecting such trees/shrubs are <u>IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS</u>. (There is <u>NO</u> relief from staked trees in penalty areas)
- iii) All fixed sprinkler heads are <u>IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS</u> and relief from interference may be obtained under Rule 14.3b. In addition, if such an obstruction on, or within two club lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty as follows:- If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.
- iv) All stakes (except those defining out of bounds)
- v) Rock/Boulder tee signs, hoops, ropes, distance markers, direction signs and course furniture (Seats, Bins Ball Washers etc).
- vi) All Amenities Buildings and Emergency Weather Shelters
- vii) All wheel ruts and depressions created by a mower, tractor or other motor vehicles in the General Area.
- viii) Green edging grooves. If a ball lies in or on an edging groove around the green surround or putting green, or if the groove interferes with the area of a player's intended swing, the ball may, without penalty, be lifted, cleaned and placed in the nearest position to where it lay that is not neared the hole and avoids interference by the condition, whether on or off the putting green
- ix) Any area bounded by a white paint line.
- x) All New Work to be treated as GUR, Relief to be taken in accordance with Rule 14.3b
- xi) All Washouts in Bunkers

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE Stroke Play – Two Strokes; Match Play – Loss of Hole

Distance sprinkler head measurements are in metres to the centre of the green. Distance Indicators in Fairway - Red 100 mtrs, Blue 150 mtrs, Yellow 200 mtrs. Player rest rooms and water coolers are located at holes 5 & 15. Pace of Play - Please be aware of your position with the group ahead. Penalties may apply.
